INITIATIVES

- ▼ Initiative 41 – an effort to grow and expand new industry clusters, such as aerospace, to create an economy more resilient to change in federal defense spending. Specific initiatives include recruiting, retaining, and developing talent; and promoting and building regional capacity along the I-41 Corridor.
- ▼ Aviation Business Park Development – a joint venture by Winnebago County and the City of Oshkosh led to the creation of the Aviation Business Park adjacent to Wittman Regional Airport with the aim of bringing in a variety of aviation businesses.
- ▼ GO-EDC Foundation, Inc. – a charitable foundation with the purpose of enhancing areas of economic distress and combating poverty in Oshkosh’s downtown and redevelopment areas.
- ▼ Business Retention & Expansion Program – a visitation program focused on identifying and analyzing business strengths and weaknesses to help keep the local economy thriving and growing.
