

Winnebago: Catch – A – Ride CAR

About the Program

This service will provide 24/7, on demand employment transportation services for workers throughout the greater Oshkosh area. Grant funds will be used to subsidize fares and mileage costs and make available services affordable to unemployed, underemployed, disabled, and low-income workers through the Winnebago County Employment Transportation Feonix Mobility Rising Program.

This program is not meant to duplicate services, but rather fill in the gaps for existing transportation services throughout Winnebago county. Therefore, this service cannot be used in areas or during times when other viable public transportation is readily available.



Participants

Any individual requesting a ride to work, and falls outside the service areas and times of existing public transportation options qualify, and therefore can apply to become a rider and utilize this service. Individuals simply fill out the form and participate in a brief orientation. All ride requests and payments will be done through the QRyde mobile application.

This program is dependent on volunteer drivers. Ideally, if an individual who already drives to work would like their mileage paid for, can pick up coworkers and can get reimbursed. Drivers may accept or deny any ride request.

Cost of Service

- \$1.00 booking fee per ride
- \$0.54 per mile

Grant Subsidy

The grant will cover the \$1.00 booking fee and \$0.29 a mile, leaving the remaining \$0.25 a mile at the responsibility of the Rider.
